Test your foodie knowledge with our prize crossword and you could win a selection of great new cookbooks

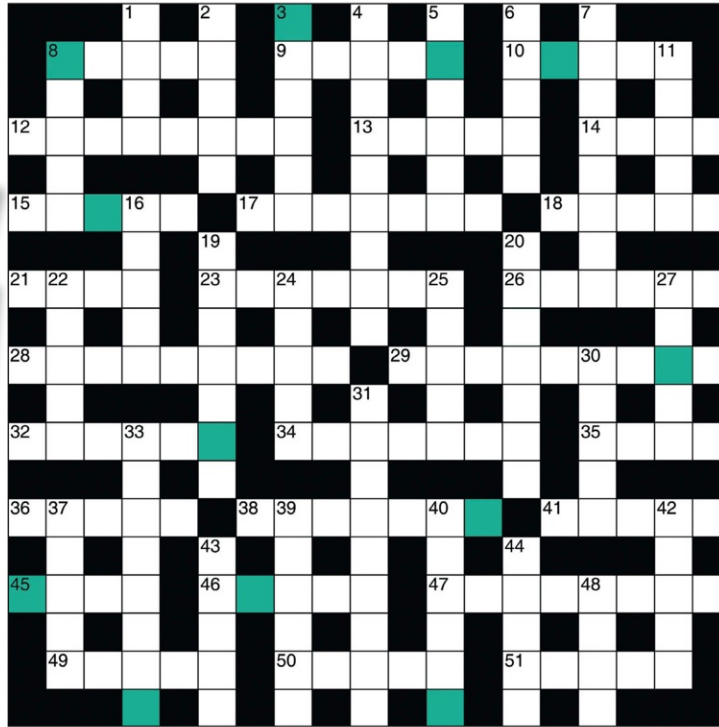
